Kindly refer to the reply dated 15.01.2015, received on 20.01.2015 in response to the online RTI application No. DOA&C/R/2015/60001 dated 03.01.2015 vide which information to the queries raised was given. Query raised in the said RTI application is reproduced here, verbatim for your kind reference: (1) On the basis of above mentioned facts, kindly explain that if M.I. Unit Delhi had become non-functional in 2004 and there is also no scope of M.I. Unit Delhi becoming functional in near future (as informed in the reply dated 14.11.2014), then why the said notification (issued in 2012) stated that initial posting will be in New Delhi under the said post. (2) Kindly provide the reason, why false, incorrect and misleading information is provided in the said notification regarding initial posting at New Delhi (while M.I. Unit Delhi was non-functional since 2004), and relying on this information candidates have applied and at the end suffered. Reply as received by the applicant read as follows: It is mentioned that the postings are decided on the basis of exigency of work in public interest. It is very significant to mention here that the query raised by the applicant was very clear, specific and straight-forward but the reply as received by the applicant was actually a statement made in general/ normal parlance which not only does not answer the query raised and indeed tries to mislead the applicant from her genuine quest for justice. The query raised was so simple and crystal-clear as it only seeks to have a clarification on the issue that when M.I. Unit Delhi was non-functional since 2004, the candidates would be given initial posting at New Delhi, when they themselves were truly aware that giving initial posting at New Delhi under the said post was not possible. A correct, unambiguous and specific reply to the query raised is of utmost importance for the applicant as she faithfully relied on the notification and applied but at the end suffered from not receiving initial posting at New Delhi, that resulted in grave loss of

The appeal filed by Ms. Kalpana Bhagat, under RTI Act, 2005 came up for hearing before me on 18.03.2015.

2. The CPIO submitted that information sought by the Applicant vide RTI application dated 03.01.2015, regarding issue of the notification in 2012 for the post of Market Intelligence Inspector (Economics) in the Directorate of Economics and Statistics was already provided vide this Directorate Letter File No. A-48013/1/2015-E.II.ES dated 15 January, 2015 informing that postings are decided on the basis of exigency of work in public interest.
3. The applicant in her appeal dated 10.2.2015, which is transferred to FAA (DES) on 12.03.2013 sought for an unambiguous and specific reply for the query received on 3.01.2015.
4. It is clarified that the recruitment policy and place of posting are decided on the basis of exigency of work and in public interest and it is emphasized that the post carries all India service liability.
5. The requisite information has already been furnished and clarified to the applicant and no further information could be furnished under RTI Act 2005.
6. The appeal is disposed off.
